

The Tallest Tree in Michigan is Chopped Down

The Story

To the disbelief of many Michigan residents, the Milatree is no longer. Once standing tall at *eight thousand and fifty feet* high, the tallest tree in Michigan was cut down by a member of the anti-tree cult, **Mark Notree**, on January 23, 2021. The Milatree has been around since 1789, planted by George Washington. On January 30, the residents of Lansing will hold a ceremony in honor of the tree.
